#### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

The Bognor Regis Motor Club Ltd will organise a series of Clubman's Grass Autotests to be held at Kestrel Farm, Harbolets Road, West Chiltington, West Sussex RH20 2LQ. West Sussex (MR 198/109197).

1. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations.
2. MSA permit numbers: 04 June 2017 - TBC
3. The event is open to members of the organising club, Central Sussex MC, Cranleigh MC, Farnborough DMC, HRCR, Southsea MC and any other invited motor club.
4. Competitors must produce a valid club membership card.
5. The program of the meeting will be as follows: - Scrutineering starts at 10.00 am and any competitor not signed on by 11.00 am may be excluded. First test will start at 11.00 am.  
  
The event will consist of 3 classes as follows: -
  - a) Saloons with engine over driven wheels.
  - b) All other Saloons.
  - c) Sports Cars and Specials.
6. Awards will be presented as follows:-

7. The entry list opens on publication of these SR's and closes one hour prior to the start time on the day of the event. The entry fee in advance

is £12. Entries on the day will incur a £3.00 premium. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the correct fee. It is acceptable to send an email confirming attendance, and complete an entry form on the day, by 10 am.

8. The maximum entry for the meeting is 30. The minimum is 8. The maximum for each class is 20; the minimum 3. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the event or amalgamate classes as necessary. In the event of adverse weather conditions the organisers have the right to cancel the event. Entry fees may be refunded at the organisers' discretion.

10. Times will be posted throughout the day and Provisional results will be announced as soon as possible following the last finisher. Protest must be made within 15 minutes of the results being announced as provisional, otherwise they will be declared final and the awards will then be presented. The final results will be posted or emailed to all competitors.
11. Any protest must be made in accordance with Regulation C.5.1 - 5.7.

12. A) Details of tests will be available at signing on.  
B) Each driver will have two runs at each test with the best time to count  
C) Timing will be by hand held digital watches.  
D) The starting signal will be given verbally by the start marshal.  
E) No competitor shall carry a passenger whilst competing (SR M.12)  
F) Competitors must be aged 16 or over. Competitors without a valid RTA (Road Traffic Act) licence must comply with GR M.13
13. Practising will not be allowed although walking of the tests will be allowed before each set of tests.
14. Penalties will be applied as per Table M7 in 2017 edition of MSA Specific Regulations M-Autotests
15. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written except the following:-

Specific Regulation M.6.6. Pylons may be less than 1 metre in height.

Specific Regulation M.5.1. In consequence of the whole event taking place on private property, vehicles need not be taxed or hold a current MOT certificate.

Four wheel drive vehicles are allowed (but no 'knobbly'/off-road tyres allowed)
