ORGANISATION

- 1 Bognor Regis Motor Club Ltd will organise their 15th Regis "TAP". A Touring Assembly & Picnic on Sunday 7th September 2025. This is a non-competitive tour giving participants the opportunity to drive a scenic route and visit some interesting locations along the way.
- 2. The event will be held under a Certificate of Exemption issued by Motorsport UK, these Regulations & any written instructions that the Organisers may issue for the event. The event has no competitive element. A Competition Licence is not required for the event. Entrants do not need to be members of the organising Club or any other motoring organisation but need a full driving licence. Motorsport UK Event Permit/Certificate of Exemption No: TBA

ELIGIBILITY

3. The event is open to four-wheeled road cars first registered before 31st December 1995. Pre-1960 registered light commercial vehicles will be considered upon application. Interesting later cars will be accepted at the organiser's discretion.

ENTRIES

4. Entries opens as the entry system goes live at <u>www.bognor-regis-mc.co.uk</u> on 4th January 2025 for previous participants, 11th January to new participants and closes on 13th August 2025. All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the entry fee of £135.00 for two people travelling in one car (£67.50pp). Please add £65.00 for each additional passenger. Please make your cheque payable to Bognor Regis Motor Club Ltd. See entry form for BAC payments which is the preferred method of payment please. Each entry will be acknowledged (preferred method email). As in all previous years, £12.50 per person from every entry fee will be donated to Sussex Air Ambulance, subject to the minimum entry being received.

The entry fee includes: One Tulip Roadbook giving a suggested route and pre-arranged venues to visit during the tour, One rigid Tour Plate & two window stickers. Breakfast roll with tea/coffee at our exclusive private start venue, Great Ballard School, Eartham, PO18 0LR by kind permission of Sue Jay. Our Bring your own picnic venue will be at Shamley Wood Estate near Cranleigh by kind permission of Mr Rob & Mrs Claire Merriman who will be donating this fee to National Gardens Scheme charities. We are in advance negotiations with another exclusive and very interesting venue for you, as our Afternoon Tea stop – more information to follow. The finish will be at another exclusive private venue at The Tithe Barn, Old Ditcham Farm, GU31 5RQ near Petersfield again by kind permission of Jeremy & Margaret Oates MR: 197/7605 2035. There you will be served a delicious Roast Meat roll by Matt's Hog Roast. Bring your own drinks & plastic glasses. **Don't forget to bring your own picnic and chairs as you may need them at all the venues.**

The maximum number of cars on the event is 90 with 10 reserves. The minimum is 60. Should the above minimum figure not be reached, the organiser's reserve the right to cancel the event and entry fees will be refunded as per item 6. Cars will be generally seeded in age order with the oldest cars leaving first. If you wish to travel with friends let us know on the entry form.

5. Well behaved dogs on leads will be allowed at **all outdoor** venues. No dogs inside the buildings please at any of the venues. You must pick up and dispose of poo responsibly at **ALL** venues!

CANCELLATION OF ENTRY

6. The following cancellation fees will apply: Cancelling entry after taking a reserved & paid for place before 13th August 2025 – entry fee will be refunded less £12.50 donation per person for Sussex Air Ambulance & £5 administration fee. Entry cancelled after 13th August 2025 – Sorry no refund.

<u>ROUTE</u>

- 7. The Start venue will be Great Ballard School, Eartham, PO18 OLR. Map Ref:197 / 9390 0940. The first car will leave at 10.01am. The suggested route will cover approximately 100 miles in West Sussex, Surrey and Hampshire. The Finish will be at The Tithe Barn, Old Ditcham Farm, near Petersfield. GU31 5RQ. MR: 197/7605 2035
- 8. The suggested route will be given in an easy to follow "Tulip" Road Book, which will be issued to entrants at the start of the event. Although not required to complete the suggested route, participants may like to follow their progress on Ordnance Survey 'Landranger' 1:50000 maps: 185, 186 and 197 (to be confirmed) or a good quality up to date road atlas. A marked map will be available for you to copy at the start.
- 9. Route cards will be supplied but will not be stamped or signed this year. The venues will be open for specified periods, as shown, giving adequate time to visit them while they are open.

TIMETABLE

11. The timetable for the event will be as follows:

4th January 2025: On-line Entries open to previous participants and open to new participants at the Historic Rally Car Register Open Day at Gaydon on 11th January 2025

13th August 2025: On-line entries close

24th August 2025: On-line Motorsport UK Signing-on opens, Final Instructions, Driver's Brief and Seeded entry list will be posted onto the website.

Sunday 7th September 2025: 08.15 – 09.45. Arrival at Great Ballard School, Eartham, park up, collect pack and Breakfast rolls. There is a strict timetable this year – please be on site by 09.45 at the very latest.

10.00: Any crew, not present at the venue, may not be allowed to start and may forfeit their entry to a reserve. 10.01: First car leaves the start at Great Ballard School with cars following at 1 minute and/or under intervals.

17.00: Approximately first car due back at the finish at The Tithe Barn, Old Ditcham Farm, Ditcham

DOCUMENTATION

12. Cars/Entrants must arrive at the start between 08.15 - 09.45.

All participants must ensure that they have a current MOT Certificate and Road Fund Licence (if needed) plus adequate insurance to enter the event for the vehicle entered. They will be required to confirm a declaration to this effect on the Entry Form by 13th August 2025.

- 13. Any vehicle, which, in the opinion of the organisers, is deemed inappropriate or unsafe, will not be allowed to start. Cars must not display any advertising or carry any competition numbers on the doors, without prior permission from the organisers. Please ensure your vehicle is in a safe, clean and tidy condition. There will be no Scrutineering at the venue.
- 14. At Great Ballard entrants collect their Tour Pack containing: Tour Plate, window stickers, Road Book and Route Check Card. They will also receive wrist bands for breakfast roll/coffee, visit to our picnic venue, visit with afternoon tea still being finalised and Roast Meat roll, with tea/coffee (one each per person) at the finish at The Tithe Barn, Old Ditcham Farm.

Please note there will be no cash bar at the finish. Please bring your own drinks & plastic glasses if you require anything.

Please drive responsibly, respecting the road conditions and other road users, our marshals and the staff at our venues, ramblers, dog walkers, horses and cyclists.
